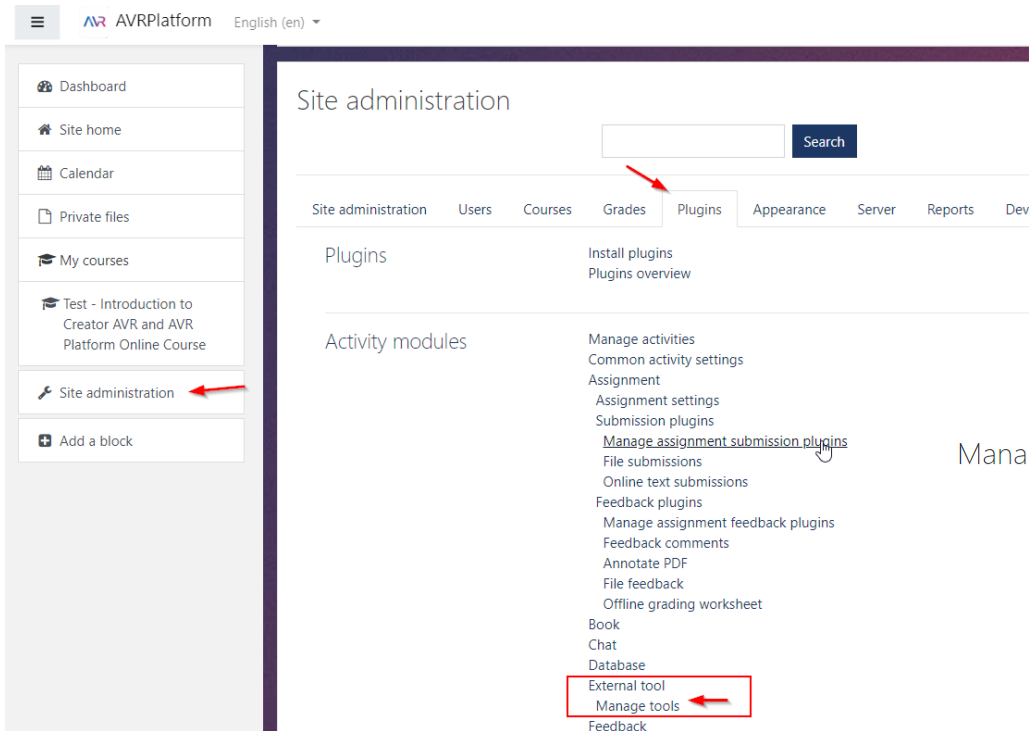
Setting up LTI for SSO



Updates for LTI

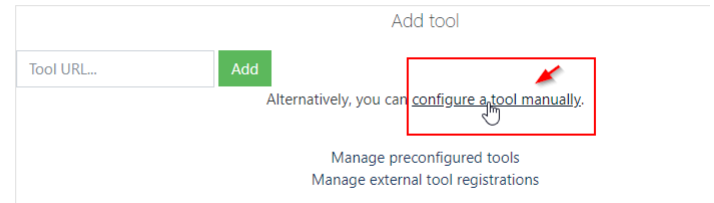
- Sakai setting is different as compared to CANVAS
 - To explore option for more generic LMS and have a part for the XML
- LTI setting needs to be accessible by all admin
 - Settings is viewable by all
 - Config setting (by root adm)
 - LTI by all admin
- If LTI setting is not configured correctly, it will fail.
 - Do we have logging?
 - Best to log the entire request (textfile) and (audit success and fail LTI) calls
 - This affects reports (login report)
 - To the event that we need to call when login success or fails.
 - Audit account provision, success and failure.

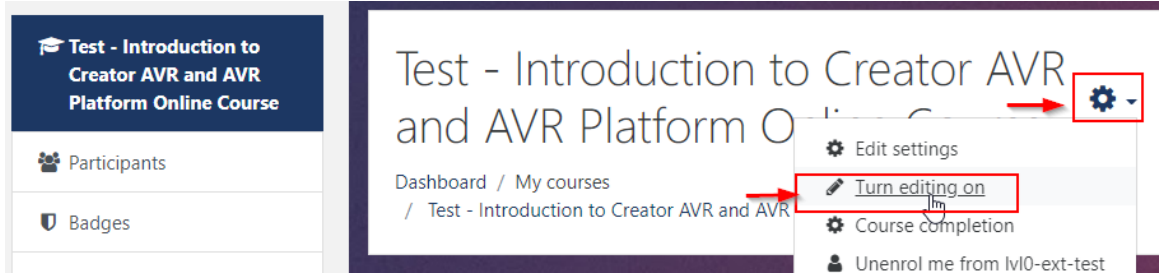

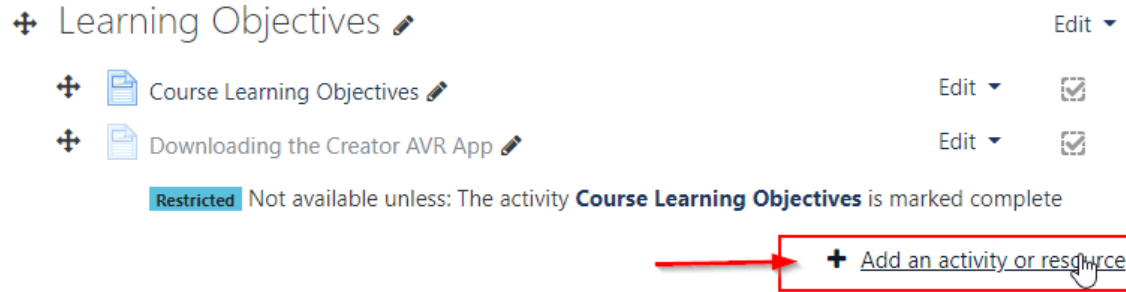

How to integrate the LTI SSO in a moodle course

1. Open your course, and turn on editing

The external tool activity module enables students to interact with learning resources and activities on other web sites. For example, an external tool could provide access to a new activity type or learning materials from a publisher.

To create an external tool activity, a tool provider which supports LTI (Learning Tools Interoperability) is required. A teacher can create an external tool activity or make use of a tool configured by the site administrator.

External tool activities differ from URL resources in a few ways:

- External tools are context aware i.e. they have access to information about the user who launched the tool, such as institution, course and name
- External tools support reading, updating, and deleting grades associated with the activity instance
- External tool configurations create a trust relationship between your site and the tool provider, allowing secure communication between them

Indicate the following types of Content Item/Deep Link Selection launches this tool can handle. Not all tools can handle types of launches. If you enable a tool which is not capable of responding to a particular request, it will likely fail when you try to use it.

- Allow the tool to be launched as a link (this is typically true for most tools)
- Allow external tool to configure itself (the tool must support the IMS Content-Item or Deep-Link message)
- Allow the tool to be used from the rich content editor to select content (the tool must support the IMS Content-Item or Deep-Link message)
